

# HOW THE COMPENDIUM IS DESIGNED



○ | We have added over a dozen companies since the April 2007 edition.

While we continue to use the ¼ page format for each listing, we will be migrating to a ½ page format in June 2007. Along with this change in listing size comes a significant increase in the amount of information available for each company. For instance, we will provide you information concerning the operating system compatibility. In addition we will offer information about practice environment for which each program is appropriate. We will provide a graphic representation of office sizes, indicating for which size office the EHR program’s developers believe it is most appropriate. We will address the issue of stand alone EHR vs. combined EHR/PM system.

We will provide information concerning the company’s beliefs relating to Dragon NaturallySpeaking Compatibility, evaluating this compatibility with respect to 5 different feature sets of Dragon.
