“Your new HER Scope looks very good – Congratulations!”
From the CEO of a small EHR vendor .

Yes, I too have seen the auto correction of EMR & EHR. MS Word has an automatic spelling correction mechanism and HER atomically showed up in place of EHR in my documents until I learned how to fix that problem. For those of you who may have had similar issues follow these instructions.

In MS Word from Office 2003, go to the ‘Tools’ menu, and select ‘AutoCorrect Options’. (See **Figure 1**) From the new window choose the ‘AutoCorrect’ tab.(See **Figure 2**) Type in EHR and HER will show up as the correction. Replace the “her” in the right column with “EHR” and click replace.

For Microsoft Word 2007 click the Microsoft Office Button and then click “Word Options”. (See **Figure 3**) You’ll find it near the bottom right of that window. Then choose ‘Proofing’ and then ‘AutoCorrect Options’. (See **Figure 4**) As in the previous version, from the new window choose the ‘AutoCorrect’ tab.(See **Figure 2**) Type in EHR and HER will show up as the correction. Replace the “her” in the right column with “EHR” and click replace.

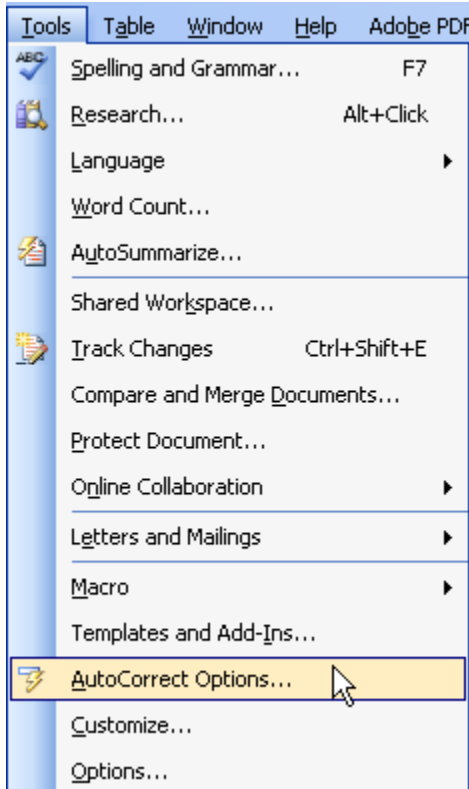

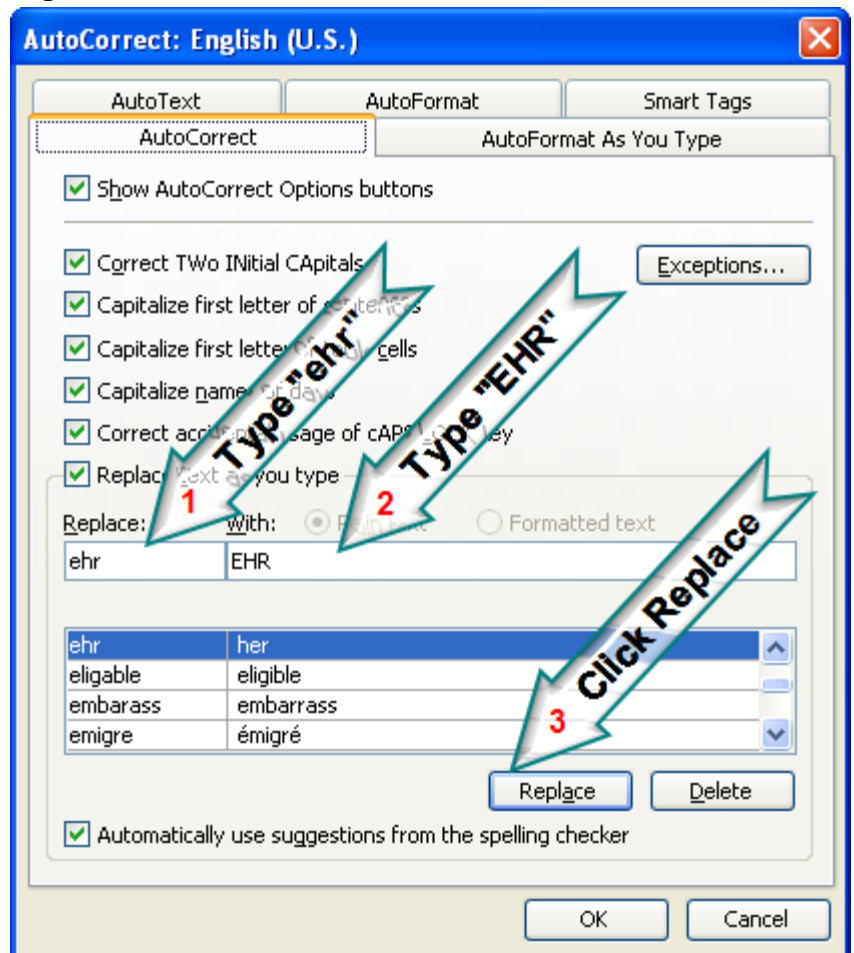
